Jewelers of America developed the Bench Professional Certification program in 1997 to promote the professionalism of jewelers and store owners. The nationally recognized certification ensures consumers are confident in the ability of the certified bench jeweler to perform quality work.

The JA Bench Professional Certification Program establishes national standards and administers tests to rate the talents and proficiency of bench jewelers at three levels. The levels are outlined below and provide more detail about the proficiency required for each level. When you enroll in the program, you simply take and pass an "open book" online written exam and a series of practical tests to become JA certified.

- Complete the application form and submit with your 1st installment payment to Jewelers of

- Successfully complete the practical test portion of the Bench Jeweler Certification at GIA.
- The completed test will be sent from GIA to the proctor, it will be graded, and the test results will be sent directly to you.

### Fees for On-Site Certification

The fee schedule for the JA Bench Professional Certification is billed in two installments. 1st installment payment is due with the completed Bench Professional Certification application. 2nd installment payment is due upon successful completion of the written exam.

#### 1st Installment: Registration and Written Exam:

#### 2nd Installment: Bench Certification Practical Tests

Practical Test **Estimated** Pricing for Beginner Bench Jeweler Exam

\$1,305 (Reflects the price of gold as of 6/1/2024)

- The Bench Certification practical test materials cost is calculated based on the price of gold at the time of shipment.
- Payment is due upon successful completion of the Bench Certification written exam.
- Jewelers of America will send an invoice outlining the amount due before the credit card on file is charged. Practical test materials will not be sent if the invoice is not paid in full.
- Check payments must be received within 7-10 days of emailed invoice.

## **Procedures for On-Site Certification**

Follow the same procedures outlined in the JA Professional Bench Certification Guide, with the exception of the Practical Test - which will be taken on-site at GIA's facility.

#### **On-Site Practical Test Procedure**

Jewelers of America will provide the practical bench tests for your level to GIA's campus in Carlsbad. You will be required to complete each practical bench test within the estimated time for completing the project during the two days allotted to complete the exam. These times are guidelines only; the candidate may take more or less than the estimated time to perform a specific bench test. However, the total test time must stay within the total time-frame requirement.

There is no need to select a proctor! A designated proctor will be provided on-site at the in-person JA Bench Professional Certification session at GIA's campus in Carlsbad. They will track the time it takes the candidate to complete each test.
